Welcome and Call to Order

The Session was called to order by Speaker Mason at 10:00 a.m.

Pursuant to Article VI, Section 9 of the Constitution of the Osage Nation, presence of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the whole number of the members of the Congress shall be necessary to constitute a meeting of the congressional house for the exercise of its powers. Pursuant to Article VI, Section 11 of the Constitution of the Osage Nation, the Congress shall keep and publish a journal of its proceedings. Motion-To Approve.
