An Act

To amend the "Fiscal Year 2008 Executive Branch Appropriation Act", ONCA 07-54, to Provide a Supplemental Appropriation to the Government Support Services Division; to declare an emergency and establish an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Congress of the Osage Nation:

SECTION 1. AMENDING SECTION 9

Section 9 is amended to read as follows:

For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2007 and ending September 30, 2008, there is appropriated the sum of three million five hundred fifty one thousand eight hundred sixty three dollars (\$3,551,863) to the Division of Government Support Services from the General Treasury fund from the following sources:







EXECUTIVE VETO MESSAGE

April 16, 2008

The Honorable Archie Mason, Speaker of the Osage Nation Congress
Members of the 1st Osage Nation Congress

Dear Mr. Speaker and Members of the 1st Osage Nation Congress:

I hereby transmit pursuant to the provisions of Section 11 of Article VII and Section 13 of Article VI of the Osage Nation Constitution, a statement of items to which I object and which I do not approve, contained in Bill ONCA 08-11, entitled:


“An Act to amend the “Fiscal Year 2008 Executive Branch Appropriation Act”, ONCA 07-54, to provide a Supplemental Appropriation to the Government Support Services Division; to declare an emergency and establish an effective date.” Inclusive

My reason for vetoing this bill is as follows:

Regrettably, I am returning Bill ONCA 08-11 without my signature as the bill is unconstitutional as written. While the purpose of this bill is to provide a supplemental appropriation of funds to Archives as requested and justified by the Executive Branch, the bill reaches well beyond the intended purpose and establishes a new department within the Executive Branch identified as “Osage News.” Establishing a new department within the Executive Branch by burying it in a supplemental appropriation is in clear violation of a provision in Article VI, Section 12 of the Osage nation Constitution which states: “Each law shall embrace but one subject, which shall be expressed in its title.”

This action, unilaterally taken by a congressional committee through the insertion of a line item and modification of the Communications Budget in the Division of Government Support Services Budget, was done without the consultation, consent or submission of a budget request by the Executive Branch which also violates Article V, Section 2 of the Osage Nation Constitution. The flawed nature of the bill and the action taken by the congressional committee precludes me from signing ONCA 08-11 while the original purpose of appropriating needed supplemental funds to Archives remains unfulfilled.
