SPONSOR: Archie Mason

**An Act**

To amend the "Fiscal Year 2008 Executive Branch Appropriation Act", ONCA 07-54, to Provide an Appropriation Modification to the Division of Education and Early Childhood Learning Services in the amount of \$-122,259; to declare an emergency; and establish an effective date.

*Be it enacted by the Congress of the Osage Nation:*

**SECTION 1. AMENDING SECTION 7**

Section 7 is amended to read as follows:

For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2007, and ending September 30, 2008, there is appropriated the sum of eight million seven hundred thirteen and three hundred thirty seven dollars (\$8,713,337) to the Division of Education and Early Childhood Learning Services from the General Treasury fund from the following sources:






