**An Act**

To amend the "Fiscal Year 2008 Executive Branch Appropriation Act", ONCA 07-54, to Provide  
a Supplemental Appropriation to the Division of Commerce, Tourism and Economic Development in the amount of \$80,231;  
to declare an emergency; and establish an effective date.

*Be it enacted by the Congress of the Osage Nation:*

**SECTION 1. AMENDING SECTION 10**

Section 10 is amended to read as follows:

For the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2007 and ending September 30, 2008, there is appropriated the sum of eight million one hundred thirty eight thousand nine hundred and seventy six dollars (\$8,138,976) to the Division of Commerce, Tourism and Economic Development from the General Treasury fund from the following sources:




