- Must have never been married or have had children
- Must own or have access to traditional Osage Dress
- Application must be accompanied by a copy of membership card
- Application must be accompanied by a current photograph, photos will not be returned
- Must be currently enrolled in school - verification required
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher - verification required
- Application must be complete and received by Osage Nation by 5:00pm, February 19, 2010, no exceptions.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered
