



National Indian Education Association Call For Artists!



The National Indian Education Association was established in 1969 and is the only national nonprofit exclusive to education issues for American Indian, Alaska Natives, and Native Hawaiian educators and students. These advocates work to keep our Native cultures in our homes, communities, and classrooms and lobby on Capitol Hill to ensure that the government maintains its trust responsibilities to the Native people of the US.

Oklahoma City will be hosting the NIEA conference at the Cox Convention Center on October 18-21 in 2012. The Local Planning Committee is looking for a theme and logo that will best combine Oklahoma's tribal cultures with technology and education. The image chosen will be used nation-wide on all publicity and promotional items. The artist will be awarded \$750 and invited to attend NIEA 2012 honor banquet.

Submission Deadline:

- February 8, 2010

Artwork Requirements:

- Logo and theme must connect our culture with technology and education.
- Design needs to be clean and simple with a contemporary feel.
- Limit design to 4 colors or less.

Submission Requirements:

- Must be a member of an Oklahoma tribe.
- Artist may not exceed two submissions.
- A separate entry form must be filled out for both submissions if you choose to do more than one.
- Submitted Images must be labeled appropriately.
- Please include short description of work on entry form.

Submission Process:

- Submissions accepted by mail or email
- Images submitted by email must be at 72dpi.
- Email to niea2012@yahoo.com with **NIEA LOGO 2012** in the subject line.
- Images sent by mail must be on a cd at 300 dpi or printed on a 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper.
- Images sent by mail should be mailed to **1819 Lakehurst Dr Norman, OK 73071** marked **ATTN: NIEA LOGO 2012**.

Acceptance Process:

- Only one image will be chosen.
- Works reviewed by NIEA LPC Theme/Logo Committee.
- Artwork will not be returned.
- The artist of the chosen image will be contacted soon after March 2010.
- Selected artwork becomes property of the LPC with the artist receiving \$750.
